## *Agility Field/Event Responsibilities*

---

Etiquette is the same as being at an agility trial.

Dogs must be on a leash at all times when not in a crate or in a vehicle.

Crate required to be closed (zipped/latched) when your dog is in the crate.

Dogs are not to be tethered.

Do not unleash your dog, until the dog coming off the course has been leashed.

Make sure your dog gives other dogs a respectful space.

Pick up poop in a bag and place it in trash receptacle.

If your dog is in heat, please have them stay home.

Volunteer to be a practice coordinator.

Practice coordinator:

- Be part of set up
- Come up with a course or practice exercise

Practice time running order:

- Sign up on the board under your dogs jump height, this allows the handler to be prepared to run, and prepare for when it is their turn
- Be waiting at the start line, ready to run when it is your turn
- You will have a designated time on the course – you may run the course, practice the parts you need to work on – it's your choice, do what is right for your dog.

You are required to participate in set up or putting away equipment.

If you arrive late, you will be added to the bottom of the run order.
